Note:

1. The West Nile IgG test identifies past infection or potential immunity and can be used for epidemiological studies.
2. False-positive IgG results may occur due to cross reaction with other flaviviruses (Dengue, Zika, Japanese encephalitis), autoimmune conditions producing non-specific antibodies like RA, ANA, SLE etc.
3. False-negative results may occur if testing is done too early in the infection, in individuals with weakened immune systems (e.g., those with HIV, on immunosuppressive therapy or chemotherapy).
4. Seroconversion between acute and convalescent sera is considered strong evidence of a current or recent infection. Therefore, a single positive IgG test without paired acute and convalescent titers has limited diagnostic utility.
